As you're now entitled to a pension from Pace DB, the defined benefit section of the Co-operative Pension Scheme (Pace), here is some information about the services we can offer you.

I'm the Pensioner Welfare Officer and I'm here to offer you support and information. If you need either, please contact me on the above number.

In this pack we've included a Life Planning – Useful Information Form which you might want to fill in and keep in a safe place.

Outlined below is some information that you may find useful.

### **Your Pension**

Your Pace DB pension is paid to you every four weeks in advance, directly into your bank or building society account.

If you have a question about your Pace DB pension entitlement, you'll need to contact the Pensions Department by email at [staffpensions@coop.co.uk](mailto:staffpensions@coop.co.uk) or by post at Co-op Pensions Department, 6th Floor, Dept 10406, 1 Angel Square, Manchester, M60 0AG. Please include your full name and pension number.

### **Accessing Your Pace DB Information Online**

If you have access to the internet and an email address, you'll be able to register for the Member Online Service which you can find on the Pace website. The website address is [coop.co.uk/pensions](https://coop.co.uk/pensions) if you're a Co-op member and [www.co-operativebank.co.uk/pensions](https://www.co-operativebank.co.uk/pensions) if you're a Bank member. Just click on the menu button and scroll down to 'Member Online' and click it. Once in the Member Online area, select 'Click Here for Help with Registration' and this will open up a step by step registration guide.

You'll need an email address and your National Insurance number, DOB and phone number to register and then you'll be able to see your P60s and payslips securely online. You won't receive any paper copies of your payslips or P60 through the post. The registration process is used to verify your identity, and as in all other on-line interactions, we encourage you to carefully consider who you share your personal information with, if for example, you need someone else to help you complete the registration process.

You'll also be able to update your personal details online, which is quicker and more accurate than asking the Pensions Department to update them for you. Once signed in there is a guide under FAQs to help you with making these updates.

### **Tax**

At the end of each tax year, your P60 will be made available online as described above. This will show your gross pension and tax deduction. If you need any further information about tax please contact His Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC), Bootle Maritime office – 0300 200 3300.

Your tax reference number is 083/MZ87073 if you're a Co-op member and 475/YB80425 if you're a Bank member. You'll be asked for your full name, date of birth and National Insurance number.

### **Change of Address/Bank Details**

If you move or change bank details, you need to let the Pensions Department know as soon as possible. You can update your details in your Member Online account or write, including your pension number or National Insurance number and date of birth or telephone 0330 606 1000.

### **Change of Name**

Should you change your name, you need to let the Pensions department know as soon as possible to ensure the data we submit to HMRC each pay period is accurate.

To enable us to update our records we require documentary evidence of your change of name. Please forward either the original document or a clear colour photocopy to the 1 Angel Square address or via email to [staffpensions@coop.co.uk](mailto:staffpensions@coop.co.uk). All original documents will be returned by recorded delivery.

### **Evergreen Magazine**

This magazine will be sent to you twice a year and is our way of keeping in touch with you. Please contact me if you feel you're a budding reporter.

### **Retired Employees' Association**

It's necessary for PACE Trustees Limited to hold your personal data and we, the Pensions Department as their administrators, will need to process this data to pay your benefits. PACE Trustees Limited are required by law to provide you with information about the Pace Scheme.

The Welfare Office will also send you additional information, such as the Evergreen magazine and, occasionally, details of special offers and REA activities. Should you prefer not to receive this additional information please write to me at the above address. You'll then only receive the information that PACE Trustees Limited are legally bound to provide.
